



THE NORTHIAM PRIMARY SCHOOL

The Northiam project was a joint initiative between East Sussex County Council and Northiam Primary School for a two-badminton court size sports hall with community access in the weekday evenings and weekends. The approximate build cost was £250k and it opened in 2008. David Fisher was the consultant for the Project. The community hours are managed by the dedicated team of Northiam School staff.

The sports hall was purpose built to provide and promote better sporting opportunities and increase the levels of physical activity for all ages in the local community. The sports hall is open throughout the whole year.

There are a range of different sports and fitness clubs offering a variety of different opportunities for adults and children throughout the week. Some of these clubs operate on a 'pay and play' basis, others require joining and payment of a membership fee. All clubs, however, welcome new faces at any time and allow you to try the particular activity before you commit yourself to regular attendance.

Term time community use is:

5.30pm – 10.30pm Monday to Friday and 8.00am – 10.30pm at weekends

Holiday time community use is:

8.00am – 10.30pm 7 days (subject to Junior Sport & Recreation programme).
