'Towards a Wider Use' was one of the most important early reports on Dual Use and Joint Provision. These extracts from the Report provide the original background to the concept.

"3. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND AND THE CASE FOR JOINT PROVISION AND DUAL USE

- 3.1. The joint planning concept began to develop in this country around 1964, when it was clear that the economic advantages in themselves could be substantial and make sense in terms of local authority budgets. The authorities active in this field recognised that large schools appearing on building programmes could contribute positively towards the provision of leisure opportunities, if school facilities were modified by the addition of financial resources other than those for school building, to allow the provision of recreation and social facilities not normally found in a school brief.
- 3.2. The development of community orientated schools enabled individuals to fulfil their leisure aspirations not only through organised classes, but by sessions set aside for individual, family or club and society participation. The key to this development was management geared to creating throughout the year valid community opportunity, where age or club membership were not a pre-requisite of use.
- 3.3. Authorities working in a corporate or co-operative way were able to consider the possibility of extending the facilities at new schools, particularly secondary schools. The schools would enjoy better facilities and opportunities than could have been provided within DES building cost limits, while local communities would gain a range of opportunity inconceivable if the local authority or authorities concerned were to attempt to plan and develop the schools without any consideration of wider community use."
