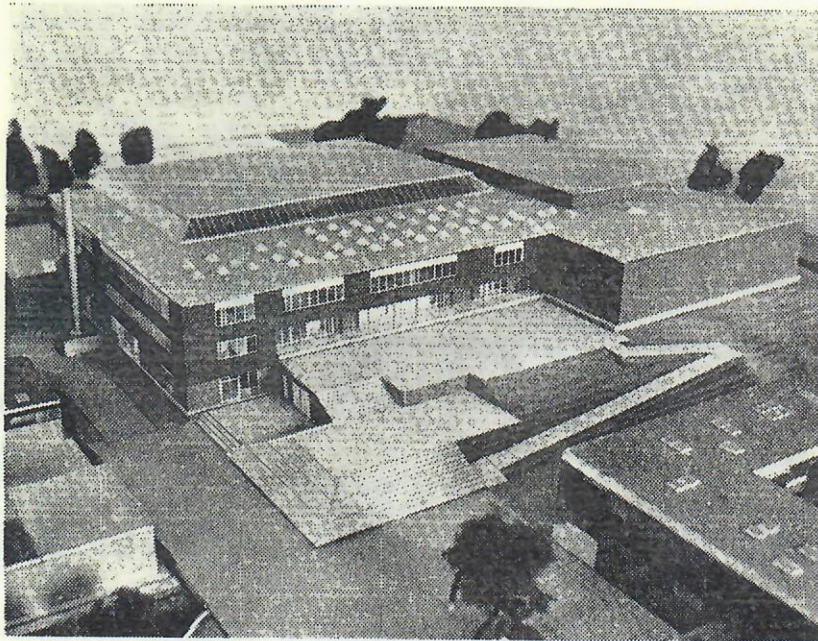

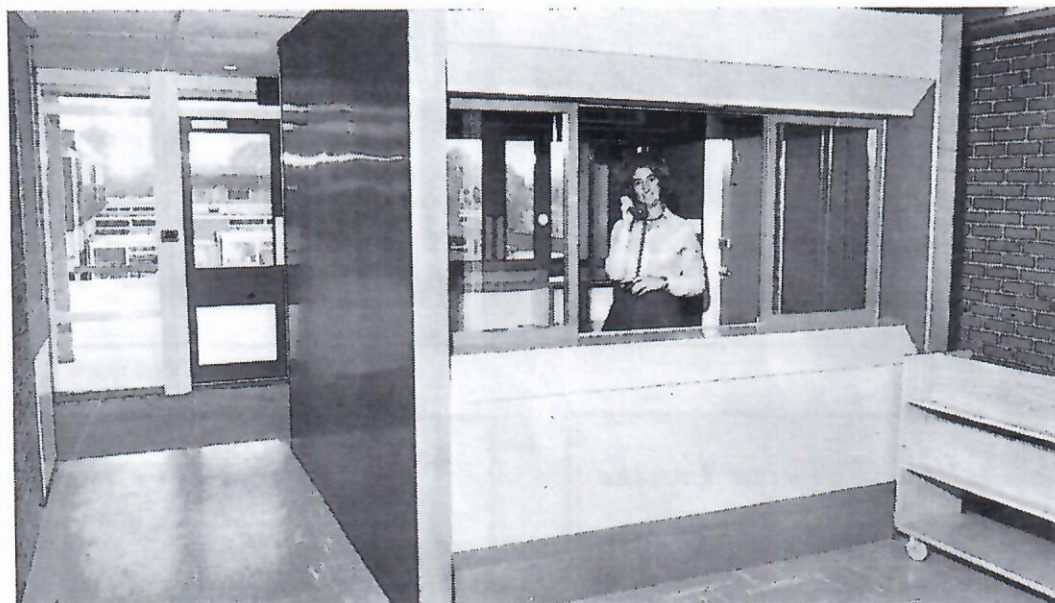

Some daytime recreation and swimming sessions will be held during the day, by arrangement with Rushcliffe School.

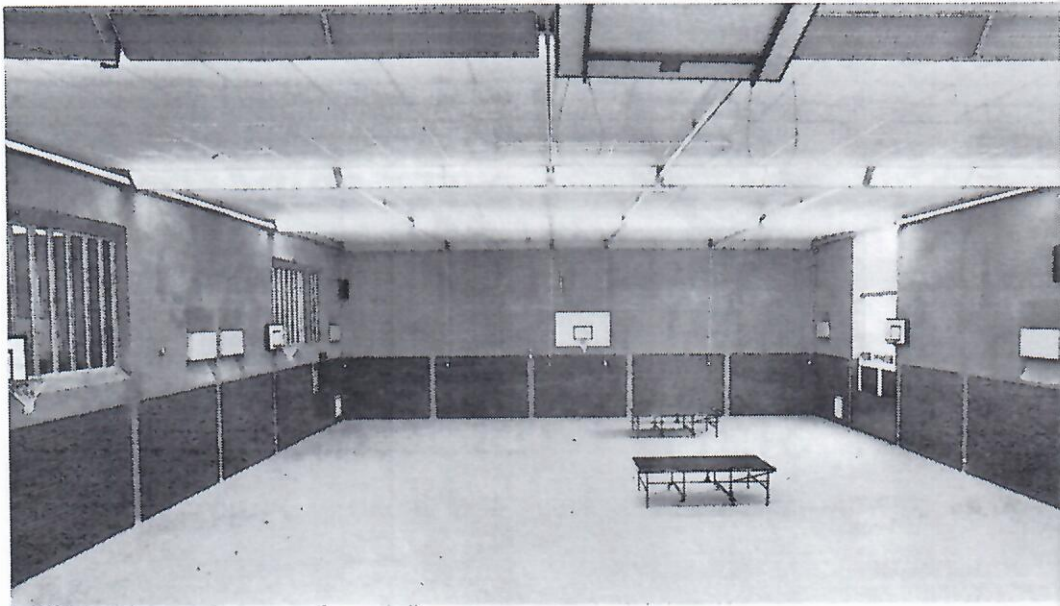
Centre opening hours may be varied to accommodate special events and sessions.

LEISURE POOL

The Leisure Pool is the main feature of the Leisure Centre, and is the first free-shaped pool to be built in the Midlands. It incorporates a beach area, a general activity area and a deep water area, as well as various other features such as lighting effects, chutes and a carpeted surround, all of which help to emphasize the idea of 'swimming for leisure'.

MAIN HALL

The Games Hall (94' x 60') is available for a large number of sports and games, including: Archery, Badminton, Basketball, Bowls, Cricket, 5-a-side Football, Fencing, Golf, Gymnastics, Netball, Tennis, Trampolining and Volleyball.
