

**OFFICIALY LISTED SPORTS CENTRES
RECORDED BY HISTORIC ENGLAND as at 2020**

[Listed buildings are subject to regulations which protect their historical and architectural significance. These buildings are of special interest, meaning alterations and building work can't be carried out without written consent from the relevant authorities]

- Brixton Recreation Centre (started 1974, opened 1985).
- York Hall in Bethnal Green (1929 and refurbished 2005-2010) - famous as a boxing venue.
- St Mary's, Southampton, former drill hall, centre for Solent University.
- Hull University Sports Centre.
- King Alfred Leisure Centre, Hove.
- Crystal Palace National Recreation Centre.
- Coventry Sports Centre (the Central Baths)
- Billingham Forum - Theatre, Auditorium, Stage and Fly Tower only (not the recreation facilities)
