WSW designed a sports hall extension and project managed the scheme, which was built in 2014 at Weydon School, Farnham in Surrey. It formed part of one of the most outstanding sets of school sports facilities in the UK. In the same year, the school had 2 full-size floodlit 3G artificial pitches installed plus a 4-lane artificial surface sprint track plus tennis/netball courts.

WSW were also architects for 'The Globe' at the School in 2017, which was the construction of a new two-storey teaching block. It was designed to provide the school with 23 extra classrooms which created lots of extra teaching and learning space. The building comprised of a steel frame and included exposed glulam beams, brise soleil and rainscreen cladding.
